Class Overview: You will be working on a 46" x 46" (46" x 62") quilt needing three different fabrics. I am suggesting red, white, and blue -- keep in mind other combinations will also work well. Plan on doing some pre-class cutting so when we start class you are ready to get the first clue and start.

Materials needed:

Fabric List for the entire project:

Before you start on the fabric search, please keep in mind that directional fabrics will be a bit of a challenge in this design, so please try to head in other directions.

Three fabrics, I have picked a blue (dark), a white (light), and a red (medium). Pieces are not big so stay away from large prints. Suggestions: a print that reads as a solid, or a print that is "packed" -- a smaller design without a lot of open spots (keep in mind it will be cut into smaller pieces, so you will want to like the effect that creates).

Fabric #1 -- blue (dark) 1 1/3 yards (1 3/4 yards) Note: add 1/2 more yards if you would consider this for binding
Fabric #2 - white (light) 1 3/4 yards (2 3/8 yards)
Fabric #3 - red (medium) 7/8 yards (1 1/8 yards)

You will need backing later -- 3 yards (3 1/2 yards) and also batting!
These fabric amounts are allowing 1/8 to 1/4 yard extra, just because you may feel a little more secure with a little extra fabric, just in case!

Necessary supply -- along with your basic sewing supplies for class:
the Strippy Stars tool by Creative Grids® (#CGRDH2)

PRE-CLASS CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From your **blue (dark)** cut the following:

cut 3 (6) - 2" x 42" strips
cut 1 - 3" x 42" strip, and cut it into 4 (7) - 3" x 3" squares
cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips, then cut these into 96 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares
cut 3 (6) - 3" x 42" strips, then cut these into 40 (64) - 3" x 3" squares

From your **white (light)** cut the following:

cut 3 (5) - 3" x 42" strips, then cut these into 32 (56) - 3" x 3" squares
cut 1 - 3" x 42" strip, and into 5 (8) - 3" x 3" squares
cut 5 - 1 1/2" x 42" strips
cut 1 - 1 1/2" x 42" strip, then cut into 12 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares.
cut 4 (6 or 7) - 2" x 42" strips.
cut 10 (14) - 2" x 42" strips

From your **red (medium)** cut the following:

cut 10 (14) - 2" x 42" strips

With all the cutting complete you are ready for class. Be sure you bring your remaining fabric for this project along with your machine and all it's parts, cutter, cutting mat, and rulers. (Anything else you might need!)
