there are lots of shapes and lots of techniques used in this quilt pattern  
we'll talk about piecing - squares, triangles, strips, flying geese.....there will be  
many different piecing techniques to learn while planning to make this quilt  
we'll also be fine tuning our piecing accuracy

**experience level**    strong beginner / intermediate and beyond

### **tool box**

sewing machine, in good working order, with manual  
small scissors and thread snippers  
cutting mat and 6-1/2 x 24" ruler    and medium size straight edge ruler  
for best results - Creative Grids CGRTMT2 and 3  
or template plastic, 8-1/2" x 11" sheet or larger  
foundation paper for 8-1/2" x 32-1/2" and 8-1/2" x 48-1/2"  
(non smear newsprint, or lightweight masking paper used for painting)  
rotary cutter with new blade (45 or 28mm)  
piecing threads in neutral grey, 3-5 loaded bobbins of the same thread  
beyond the reef pattern - Modern Medallion

pens, notebook, camera

### **fabrics**

lights and darks - (23) 3/8 yard each  
accent - 1/2 yard  
(refer to pattern for binding and backing requirements)

### **preparation**

please note the cutting instructions on the first page of the pattern

(there are a lot of moving parts to this quilt)

we will be learning different piecing techniques, so preparing the cut pieces prior to class will give us more class time for demos and piecing

even when it comes to the strip pieced triangles - please, just cut the strips

we'll work on "triangles" in class

### **miscellaneous**

bring any other items necessary for your own personal comfort

we will be testing the different techniques used in this quilt, with a lot of hands on machine time

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
