This quilt is just a whole lot of fun! Don't worry about seam allowances or straight seams. As a matter of fact, the more crooked, the better. Using random-sized strips, create wonky blocks and then even up the edges after all the blocks are sewn. Empty your mind of all the quilting rules you have learned over the years and let yourself be free! You will be introduced to the "naughty" side of quilting.

Supply List:

You will receive 2 bags of pre-cut strips in class. If you have other fabrics at home you would like to include please bring them with you and we will make sure they are included. Fabric strip bags for 2017 classes will be very bright fabrics with a few batik bags.

Sewing machine in good working order

Basic sewing supplies

Thread: This is a great opportunity to use up tail ends of old spools and bobbins. I use up to 30 different colors in each quilt. Or if you prefer, a nice neutral grey will do nicely.

Rotary cutter and mat

Rulers: Bring one or two of the following square rulers:

5 ½" x 5 ½", 6" x 6", 6 ½" x 6 ½", 8 ½" x 8 ½", or 9" x 9"

Sometime during class you will decide what size your finished blocks will be. This will determine the ruler size you will use. Blocks in my sample quilts are 6 ½" x 6 ½" (finished 6" x 6")
