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Here is your chance to do something off the wall. Using Tsukineko Inks as paints, you will create your own fabric picture in this two day workshop. You choose the subject by bringing a photo of your own. We will enlarge the photo by drawing onto a high grade of fabric. Learning the "dry brush" method of painting, you will turn this into a fabric painted piece of art. You are not limited to realism. Texture and innovative painting will also be covered, as well as finishing and quilting.

Starter kits will be available through the Stitchin Post for an additional fee of \$45.00.

Kit includes: 6 Tsukineko inks, 6 brush tip applicators, one yard of high grade white fabric (Pimatex cotton), and ¼ yard of muslin.

Freezer paper

Graphite pencil

Masking tape
