

From Inspiration to Design

Description:

Bring your inspiration to life as you create a one of a kind unique quilt pattern. Work with Heather to create a quilt pattern that is inspired by something you have seen: an old building, a water tower, the sunset, etc. In this class, we'll be using a photograph of your inspiration as a starting point and will create a quilt design based on that inspiration. Heather will guide you through the process of sketching, designing pattern pieces, calculating yardage and construction methods, creating a color palette, and fabric selection. You'll leave the class with a complete pattern that is ready to be constructed in your home studio.

Supplies:

- Photograph of inspiration, printed out at either 3" x 5" or 4" x 7"
- ❖ Masking tape or scotch tape, preferably acid free
- ❖ A variety of markers and/or colored pencils to add color to our drawn designs
- ❖ Color chips and fabric swatches that coordinate with your inspiration photo
- ❖ Calculator (the one on your phone is fine)
- \$15 supply fee for kit that includes a Rhodia graph paper sketchbook, pencil, and ruler to use in class and for you to keep
