

"CASCADE CONES - NEEDLE-TURN HAND APPLIQUE"

SUPPLY LIST

Pattern Required

FABRIC:

Background: Cut 15 1/2" x 8 1/2", Neutral Linen or Cotton

Stems: one 1/2" strip 40"ish long

Cones: one fat-quarter or 7 scraps 4"x5" each

Border: Cut 2 - 2" strips width of fabric (42")

(From these strips cut 2 - 8 1/2" sides and 2 - 18 1/2" for top & bottom.)

#8 Perle Cotton/variegated greens or browns

(Note: You may come to class with borders attached, or not. If you sew them before class, attach sides first and then top and bottom.)

NOTIONS:

Basic Sewing Supplies

!!! NO SEWING MACHINE REQUIRED !!!

Paper & Fabric Scissors

#2 pencil for tracing pattern

Chalk marking pencil

Thimble (optional)

Small sharp sewing scissors

1/4" bias tape maker

Needles: Straw or Milliners #11

50wt cotton thread in colors to match cone & stem shapes

Glass head pins (they are finer)
