Course Overview

Using thickened dyes you will paint onto fabric. The use of resists will play into this process while you create your masterpiece. June will demonstrate the use of many techniques for you to experiment with in this one day workshop. You will go home with a painting or two and written instructions on how to wash your piece and prepare it to be used.

Do not wear good clothes.

Required Supplies

- ** Painters tape
 - ** 4 paint brushes: small, medium, large, and extra large
 - ** rubber gloves
 - ** Apron or paint shirt
 - ** An image or two to draw onto the fabric
 - ** 4 kitchen size white plastic garbage bags without texture
 - ** Freezer Paper
- Paper scissors
- ** Face mask to cover nose and mouth
 - ** **Supplies not carried by The Stitchin' Post**

Optional Fabric Supplies

If you choose to bring additional fabrics, then use fabric prepared to dye soaked in soda ash: I prefer either Pimatex or a tight weave sateen.
