**Course Overview**

Learn how to create freezer paper foundations for precision piecing. This technique is similar to paper piecing but foundations are reusable and there is no tearing out bits of paper afterwards! We will use my Diamonds quilt to learn the technique, and we will discuss how to apply it to many other patterns. In this class we will also look at the use of value and color to create visually complex quilts from the repetition of a simple block.

Level: Intermediate

**Fabric Selection**

Bring a variety of light, medium and dark fabrics.

Variety of fabrics. Bring enough color choices to suit your creative style. Pick colors you love with a variety of light and dark options.

A 60" x 70" throw requires 6 ½ to 7 yds

A 24" x 25" mini requires ¾ yd
