## Course Overview

In this fusing class Frieda will teach you new easy ways to make this fun seascape quilt. Using collage techniques and raw edge fusing you will achieve beautiful effects. The pattern requires you to let go and be creative. Using organic shapes and free expressive cutting, you will create an improvisational collage using strip fusing elements and design elements to assemble this one of a kind wiall hanging. The use of decorative rotary cutter blades, such as the wavy and pinking blades, enhance the design process. This is the quilt you'll want hanging on your wall to cheer you through the winter and think of warmer places and times.

## Required Supplies

Kit which contains the pattern and fabric

4 yards or Wonder Under fusible web – it says #805 on the end of the bolt (no substitutions please)

45mm rotary cutter with straight blade and a pinking blade for the fused binding and some of the seaweed

Very sharp embroidery scissors

\*\*Mechanical pencil and extra fine sharpie marker

Rotary mat and ruler

\*\*Poster board found at office supply or craft/sewing store(optional)

\*\*One box of Reynolds brand parchment paper or a teflon pressing sheet

## Fabric Selection

You will use the teachers hand dyed cotton fabric provided in a kit
