### Course Overview

This workshop is a perfect foundation to pieced quilts using half-square triangles. We will build basic half-square triangles to form three different blocks that all come together to create the larger more complex looking block. Once you master the units, your quilt can become any size you desire.

I will be teaching this class as if we are all beginners, but should open up a world of complex looking quilts for our future.

### Fabric Selection

I do like precuts for this. Bring what you like to sew with, but think contrast, for every fabric choice, bring a contrasting fabric choice. You do not have to limit yourself to two colors, you may be creative with your color choices.

### Required Supplies

Fabrics in 5" x 5" squares. Bring four 5" x 5" packs of lights and four 5" x 5" packs of darks

OR One 10" x 10" square of each color

Your Sewing Machine, in good working order with a 1/4" foot for the machine

Good size cutting mat (Lazy Susan rotating mat is good for this class)

5" x 15" Ruler and 45 mm Rotary Cutter
