Course Overview

Waiting for Water is quilt that I made after coming home from a "once in a lifetime" trip to India. I used the warm colors of India and made the wonderful quilt using the pattern Cosmos by Colourwerx.

Fabric Selection

I used the warm colors of the East Indian women sari's. I added stripes and plaids to put some texture into the quilt. The background is chambray. I love the texture of essex, chambray, peppers as the backgrounds.

Required Fabrics and Supplies

$\frac{3}{4}$ yards each from 7 to 8 different fabrics (I used warm solid fabrics and added stripes)

5 $\frac{1}{3}$ yards of background

12 $\frac{1}{2}$ square ruler

Basic sewing supplies including: a cutting mat, ruler, cutter, and marking supplies

Required Pattern

Cosmos by Colourwerx

Class Prep

Please cut your fabrics into 3" X 14" strips. Don't cut all your fabrics. Just enough to get started and then we can talk color and design in class.
