Course Overview**CURVES AHEAD**

Does the idea of sewing curves scare the heck out of you? Don't let it! In this class, you will learn different methods of sewing curves and lots of tips and tricks that will make it FUN and EASY! We'll talk about how to square up blocks and sew them together with beautiful matching points. You will leave addicted to curves wanting to make all the quilts.

Required Fabric and Notions

28 mm rotary cutter

50 or 80 weight thread

Sewline (or your favorite) glue stick

Square up rulers in 3.5 and 6.5

20 – 30 scraps of fabric (printed or solid) that measure at least 7 inches square and that look good together

4-6 Fat Quarters in fabrics you like

1/2 yard for the background fabric

Sewing machine with a narrow piecing foot or a quarter inch foot with NO seam guide – we will be sewing these curves at a SCANT ¼”

Fabric Selection

Since we will be practicing, make sure to Not bring your most precious fabric. But DO bring fabric you like. I will have lots of examples of different blocks you can make or if you have your heart set on doing a particular block, please let me know ahead of time by emailing me at bettycrockerass@gmail.com. The example blocks may use different sizes.



Optional Supplies

We will be using **any size** of the curved template that are available on my site bettycrockerass.com/shop or at The Stitchin' Post. The larger the template the easier the curve. The best value is to buy the whole set but do what feels good to you! Each class participant will receive 25% anything on my website as well as **free shipping if you would like to pick the order up in class**. For the discount use both QA2019 and FREESHIPPING. Recommended for this class is the 3 ½" template and the 6 ½" template.

If you prefer not to purchase the acyclic templates, please email me at bettycrockerass@gmail.com and I will send you a pdf so that you can transfer them to template plastic.

Spinning (Rotating) Cutting Mat (optional but used frequently and recommended)

I recommend Sky Hawk brand

Fine glass head pins (optional but used frequently and recommended)

Square up rulers in whatever size template you will be using 2 ½", 4 ½", 5 ½" (optional but used frequently and recommended)
