Experience Level	recommend beginning with a fat quarter bundle. Your fabric needs will change depending on your fabric scale and repeat. Begin with a selection of fat quarters that you like (15-20) or a pre-packaged bundle of fat
Confident Beginner	quarters and we will build out from there.
Sewing Machine Required	Fabric selection and quantity for a quilt like this depends on a lot of factors that we will cover in the class – like fussy cutting.
No	Be prepared to add fabrics in from the selection around us at the shop. This quilt is best built as you go making fabric selections along the way.
	Required Supplies
	Paper pieces and acrylic template pack for TulaNova
	Fabric Glue Pen – I prefer the Sewline brand (craft glue sticks are not recommended)
	Glue Pen refills – at least two (any color)
	Frixion Pen – or other erasable marking tool
	Hand Sewing Needles – I prefer Tulip Size #10 Big Eye appliqué needles
	Thimble – Any type that you are comfortable with. I don't use one and my finger has paid the price, so do as I say and not as I do.
	Small Fabric Scissors – I recommend a 6 inch sharp point fabric trimmer or micro-serrated scissor.

2 to 5 Sandwich bags – to keep your basted pieces in, losing a piece is extremely traumatic.

Thread – Aurifil 50 wt small spools, a variety of colors to match your fabrics

18mm rotary cutter
