Course Overview

Words are singularly the most powerful force available to humanity. They have energy and power with the ability to help, heal, hinder, hurt, harm, humiliate and to humble. Let's put your words into fabric and share your voice with the world. You will be working with a new curvy alphabet I've designed – each letter is pieced into the fabric.

Fabric Selection

Each letter takes about an 1/8 of a yard of foreground and about a fat quarter of background fabric. The letter construction goes pretty fast – if you are quick sewist you'll probably finish about 10 letters. Make sure that your foreground and background are contrasting. If you'd like help laying out your quilt a head of time please send me an email!

Required Supplies

28 mm rotary cutter

50 or 80 weight thread

Sewline (or your favorite) glue stick

Sewing Machine with a narrow piecing foot or a quarter inch foot with NO seam guide – we will be sewing these curves at a SCANT 1/4"

Optional Supplies

We will use my 3 1/2" and 4 1/2" templates that are available on my site bettycrockerass.com/shop. Each class participant will receive 25% anything on my website as well as **free shipping if you would like to pick the order up in class**. For the discount use both QUILTCON19 and FREESHIPPING.

Square up rulers in 2.5, 3.5, 4.5, 5.5, and 6.5 – I prefer Creative Grids

45 mm rotary cutter

Rotating Cutting Mat - I recommend Sky Hawk brand

Clover 28mm rotary cutter

Class Prep

Press Fabric!

Things to Note

Quilt is 86" x 90"

Ascenders/Descenders block finish at (b, d, f, g, h, l, j, k, l, p, q, t, y) = 9" x 14 ½"

Bar (a, c, e, m, n, o, r, s, u, v, w, x, y, z) = finish at 9" x 10"

J finishes at = 9" x 19"
