Sewing Machine Required

****Supplies not carried by The Stitchin' Post**

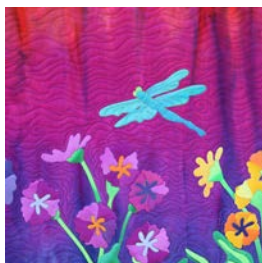
Fabric Selection
