Course Overview

Curvelets

Slow down, take a seat, quiet your mind, and start stitching. In this class we will learn how to prep, mark, cut, hand sew, and piece together these tiny curves that finish at 1 inch! Don't let it scare you – embrace these tiny curves as something fun and new that you can take this wherever you go! This is a confidence beginner level class and no prior hand sewing skills are needed.

Fabric Selection

Scraps that measure at least 2 inches square (mini charms work great here)
A fat quarter of a neutral color

Required Notions

28 mm rotary cutter or smaller

fabric scissors (about 6 ½")

50 or 80 weight thread

Straw/Milliner needle is size 10, 11, or 12. (I tend to like the 12 – long and thin – if you know you like short ones bring those!)

Sewline (or your favorite) glue stick

Small appliqué pins

Your favorite thimble

We will use my 1 ½" template that will be available on my site bettycrockerass.com/shop. Each class participant will receive 25% anything



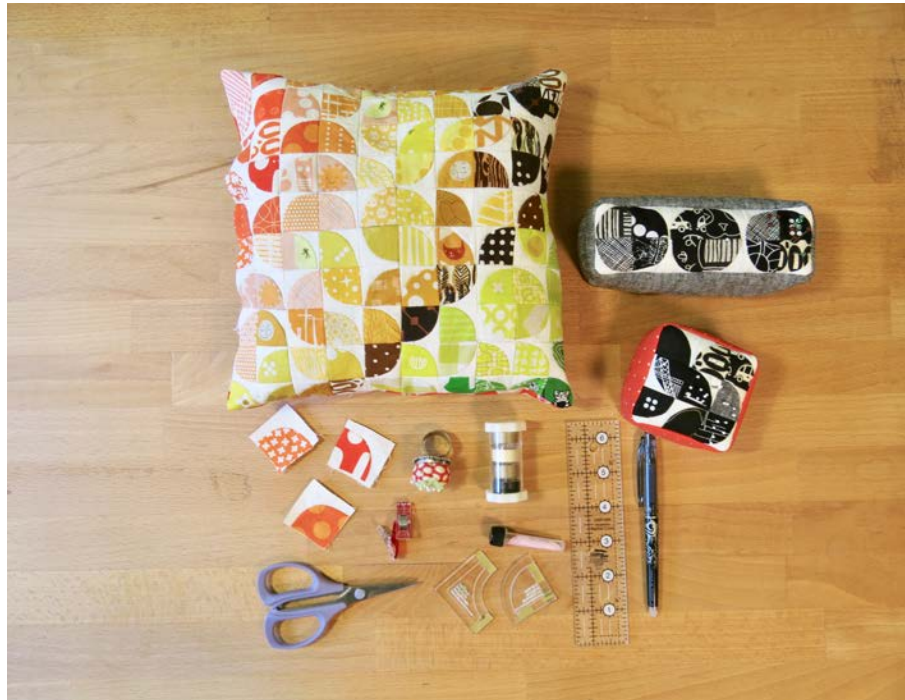

Spinning (Rotating) Cutting Mat (optional but used frequently and recommended)
