In class you will enlarge your photo onto fabric and create your fabulous wall art using Tsukineko Inks. You will learn how to control the inks, creating value changes, intensity, sharpness of line and texture. June will share color blending and other tricks of the trade. You will surprise yourself how easy it is to recreate your photo and be successful. By the end of this two day workshop you will have wall art ready to quilt.

## Supply List:

Inspirational Photo (your choice of landscape, an animal, still life, a person, event, or abstract)

**Note: items marked with \* will not be carried at either The Stitchin' Post or the school store at the high school.**

\*Pencil and eraser  
Freezer paper  
\*Masking tape  
Scissors

Tsukineko Inks: at least 6 colors. I like to make sure to have cool grey and black.

2 brush tip Fantastix applicators for each color with caps.

One yard of tight weave fabric: I prefer white Ultra Sateen by Kauffman or white Pimatex by Kauffman, or a light (White) batik.

1/4 yard muslin

Kits will be available through the Stitchin Post for \$42.00. They will include the following:  
6 Tsukineko Inks — 4 colors of your choice plus cool grey and black, 12 brush tip applicators with caps, 1/4 yard muslin and 1 yard white Pimatex.

Tsukineko Inks are available through the Stitchin Post year around.
