

## Small Stitched Landscapes with Deborah Boschert

Create small fabric compositions full of texture, color and stitching inspired by nature. Each student will design four 4x4 inch art quilts that can be mounted as an inspired grouping. Learn intuitive tricks for design and composition. Explore several hand embroidery stitches. Combine various fabrics for maximum effect and detail.

All Levels, Design Class, finished work will be a set of four 4x4 inch fabric collages that work together as a complete landscape design

### Kit Fee \$8

#### Kit Includes

- several fabric to choose from to create your own original small landscape
- 4 squares of pre-fused felt for batting
- 4 squares of pre-fused fabric for backing

### Supply List

- **embroidery floss and/or perle cotton** A sandwich size plastic bag full of floss will give you lots of options. Choose darks and lights in a variety of colors. Feel free to bring other fibers you like to use for hand stitching.

*If you don't have embroidery floss in your stash, I suggest bringing 8 to 12 skeins in a variety of colors including darks and lights*

- **embroidery needle plus thimble and needle threader** (if you use them)
- **pins**
- **special glasses or magnifier** (if you use one for hand stitching)
- **rotary cutter, ruler (6x12 is great), small rotary mat**
- **scissors**, large and small
- **sketchbook, pen and pencil**
- **creative spirit!**

### Optional

- *Art Quilt Collage: A Creative Journey in Fabric, Paint and Stitching* by Deborah Boschert
- additional small scraps of unique fabrics with lots of texture — up cycled clothing, lace, silk, burlap, cheese cloth
- digital camera (You probably have one on your phone.)
