

Paint Chips

Level of Experience: Beginner to Advanced

Approximate Finished Size: "52 x 73"

This is a fun quilt to make with many options along the way. From a "Self Setting" border to randomly added accent strips, you'll enjoy the freedom this design provides! You'll learn the secret to designing your own blocks OR follow the pattern step by step.

Fabric Tips: Choose a main fabric for the background, and then select contrasting colors for the blocks. I used solids for the blocks with a soft gray fabric for the background. However you can choose to use solids or prints with a light or dark background, it's your call.

Supplies

Book: Stack, Shuffle and Slide by Karla Alexander

Basic rotary cutting and sewing supplies

Sewing Machine in good working order

Optional: 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" ruler or larger

Fabric for the Blocks

1 Fat Quarter each of 10 different fabrics

Fabric for the Border

2 1/2 yd fabric for the background sashing, inner and outer border

1/3 yard fabric for narrow inner border

5/8 yard fabric for binding

3 1/2 yard for backing

OPTIONAL: 2 yards flannel for design wall

PLEASE WAIT TO CUT FABRIC FOR BLOCKS UNTIL YOU ARE IN CLASS.
