

This quilt uses a wide variety of Kaffe fabrics that are accented with stripes, dots & plaids. You can use a wide variety of florals. It would look great in traditional, Asian, or maybe Christmas.

Size 58" square

Basic sewing supplies (Ruler, mat & rotary cutter)

Machine in good working order

"Quilt in a Day" 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squaring up ruler

FABRIC: I used 10 different fabrics.

- a) green $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- b) light green $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- c) dark pink $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- d) light gray floral $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- e) dark strip $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- f) light plaid $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- g) small floral $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- h) dark purple $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (used for binding also)
- i) large floral 1 yard
- j) large floral 1 yard (both these large floral are similar in colors, just different flowers)

Bring extra fabrics that you think go but not sure. We will audition fabrics for you quilt.

PRE CUTTING:

If you want to do some precutting, cut each fabrics into (2) 7" X WOF strips. I don't want you to cut more than that until you have your final fabrics decided.
