

## Machine Applique Class (Turned-edge)

### Orange Juice by Cristy Fincher

#### Supply List:

- ☒ 1 Fat Quarter of Background Fabric
- ☒ 2-5 Fat Quarters for the Applique (Fat eighths or scraps can also be used.)
  - \*\*Basting Glue – Elmer's Washable School Glue is my favorite, and is preferred
- ☒ Micro Fine Glue Tips – these tips attach to the top of the Elmer's Washable School Glue bottle and create the fine line of glue that's essential for glue basting the applique (available the school store or at [www.PurpleDaisiesQuilting.com](http://www.PurpleDaisiesQuilting.com))
  - \*\*Spray Starch – please use spray starch, not a starch alternative. Faultless is my favorite brand.
- ☒ Scissors – for both paper and fabric
- ☒ Rotary cutter, mat and rulers –
  - o Recommended ruler sizes: 4.5"x12.5 and 8.5"x8.5"
- ☒ Glue Stick – I like the disappearing purple Elmer's Washable School Glue Sticks
- ☒ Thread for the Applique –
  - o Clear Sulky Monofilament or a color that matches your applique fabric. I highly recommend \*\*Wonderfil's DecoBob (80wt poly) or \*\*Invisifil (100 wt poly) or silk thread.
- ☒ Straight Pins
- ☒ Seam Ripper – we all end up needing one, once in a while ;)
  - \*\*Stapler with Staples
  - \*\*Wooden Cuticle Stick
- ☒ Basic Sewing Supplies
- ☒ Sewing Machine in good working order (remember your power cord and bobbins!)
- ☒ Schmetz Machine Embroidery Needles – size 75/11 or 90/14

NOTE: Items marked with \*\* not carried by The Stitchin' Post or the school store.

#### Optional, but recommended:

- ☒ Colored Pencils & Marking Pen/Pencil
- ☒ Prewash your applique fabrics, but not your background fabric

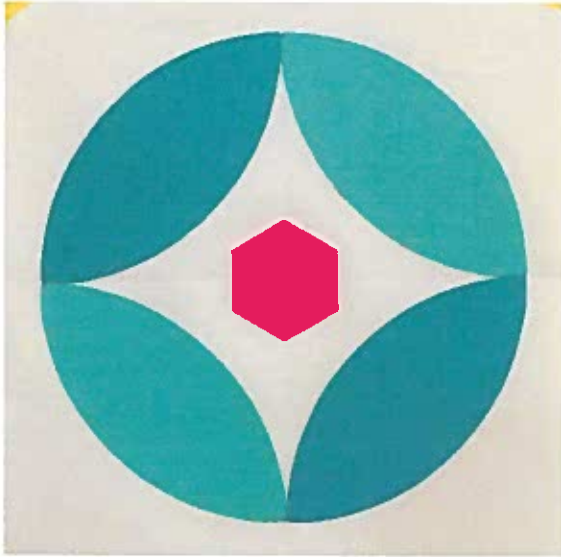
